6.14.b Educational Services Following Mental Health Treatment Involving Threats or Self-Harm

When a student receives inpatient or outpatient mental health treatment resulting from harming or threating to harm others or resulting from self-harm or threats of self-harm, the Board has the discretion, subject to applicable federal and state laws, to place the student in an alternative educational setting, including but not limited to alternative school or homebound services, until the mental health provider evaluates the student, finds that the student is not a threat to other students or staff, and notifies the Board of that fact.
